

TARGET Talking About Risk in the Context of Genomic Tests

Recurrence scores from gene expression profiling tests are used to determine the likely benefit of adjuvant chemotherapy in early stage breast cancer. Discussions with anxious patients about risk and uncertainty and the rationale for different treatment recommendations can be complex and confusing. The TARGET programme aims to help clinicians with these conversations.
