## **RECRUITMENT UPDATE (as of 31st July 2024)**

A total of 109 participants have now been randomised.


We have reached our monthly recruitment target for the last 5 months!! Keep up the great work everyone.

## **University Hospitals Plymouth NHS Trust - Derriford Hospital**

Our team here at Plymouth is made up of Professor David Sheridan, Principal Investigator, Dr Tamar Avades, Sub-Investigator, Hepatology Nurse Consultant Amanda Clements, Hepatology Advanced Clinical Practitioners Percy Hendry and Katie Ramos and Research Nurses Kelly Bowers, Sasa Topol and Sheeba Rose.

Our site opened in March 2023, and to date, we have recruited 6 participants.

Our specialist hepatology nursing team are quick to identify any individuals that are potentially suitable for the study and will discuss this at MDT, sharing the results of these discussions with the research team.

## Meet the Team ..... (cont.)

As a team, we ensure that we explain the LTAD and LVP arms of the study from a neutral position, not showing a preference for either arm. Despite this, many of our participants have expressed a clear preference for the LTAD arm. Only one of our recruits have been randomised to LTAD and the remaining 5 have been randomised to LVP. Managing some of the participants' disappointment of being randomised to the LVP arm has proved to be one of the most challenging aspects of the study.

Although challenging at times, it is an absolute privilege to be part of this study. The participants let us into their lives at such a difficult stage of their disease progression. We have gotten to know the participants and their families, and I hope that we have been successful in providing an extra layer of support to both. There have been laughs, there have been tears, participants have shared with us their most precious of memories as well as fears of what's to come.

We hope that the lived experience of all RECUCe2 participants throughout the study will help to develop a very clear set of guidelines to ensure that all patients can receive drainage of ascitic fluid, the way that they would prefer at the end of their lives.

## **Top Tips & FAQs**

#### Documents to be sent after randomisation

Please send the following documents to <a href="reduce2@bsms.ac.uk">reduce2@bsms.ac.uk</a> via Secure email:

- Patient consent form
- Eligibility Checklist signed by PI / Co-PI to confirm eligibility
- Caregiver consent form (if applicable)
- Expression of Interest forms for the Qualitative Interview for the patient and / or caregiver, if applicable. These will then be forwarded to SHORE-C.

These should be sent within 1 week of randomisation.

#### **Finances**

Please let the Trail Manager know about any travel expenses for:

- Site staff to research home visits (up to £100 per patient)
- Patients on LTAD arm for Baseline Visit (up to £30)

Please supply receipts or mileage.

## **Ambulatory Health Care (AHCR) Questionnaires**

If there is **no** Caregiver, then the following sections can be left blank:

- Section 4: Care giving
- Section 6: Caregiver's Burden Scale in End-of-life care
- Section 8: Caregiver Views About Healthcare and Social Services Received

All other sections can be completed by the Caregiver or Participant.
